## Could you write like Bernard Shaw?

Offered for the first time in 2011, this award in memory of the late T F Evans was for a sequel or additional scene for a Shaw play, reflecting not only his literary style but his wit and wisdom

17 entries were received by the closing date of 31 July 2011. The panel of judges (Sir Michael Holroyd, Barbara Smoker, Sam Walters, Sylvia Syms and Alan Knight) were impressed by the high standard of entries received but decided to make the award to Theodore D Kemper of New York for his sequel to *Candida*. The presentation of the award, and a performance of the winning entry, will take place at the meeting of the Shaw Society on 27 January 2012.

The Shaw Society / T F Evans award is open to all ages, professions and nationalities. Details of the 2012 award will be announced in January, with a closing date of 31 July 2012.
